Activities utilizing this syllabus must include selected tasks as described in the Practical Test Standards (PTS) for the Sport Pilot, Recreational Pilot, or Private Pilot, as appropriate, in the topic determined to be the primary accident causal factor for a particular category and class of aircraft.

A Sport Pilot must meet the standards in the Sport Pilot PTS, a Recreational Pilot must meet the standards in the Recreational Pilot PTS, and a Private, Commercial, or Airline Transport Pilot must meet the standards in the Private Pilot PTS, for the Category and Class in which the pilot is rated.

Airmen may use an FAA-qualified and approved flight simulator or flight training device to complete certain flight task requirements when authorized by the applicable Practical Test Standards (PTS). The Practical Test Standards for Sport, Recreational, and Private Pilot - Airplane do not authorize the use of such equipment. We strongly encourage course providers to clearly indicate which of their flight tasks may be accomplished in such equipment in lieu of aircraft.

Proficiency must be demonstrated in the tasks listed below, as a minimum, for the appropriate Category and Class and Pilot Certificate held. Pilots demonstrating that level of proficiency and incorporating such skills into their flying habits will have mitigated that topic as an accident causal factor.
